

In the past couple of years we have gained new members, while other members have done more work on their layouts. It was suggested at the March meeting that we revive the layout of the month program this spring and continue it into the 2013 -2014 Division One year. Jerry Sahagian has volunteered to kick things off by having his layout open on Saturday, April 27 in the afternoon from 1 -4 PM. More information about Jerry's layout and his open house is on the Division One web site and will be available at the meeting on the 26th.

As noted earlier, the April meeting will be the last formal meeting of the 2012 – 2013 year. Traditionally in May, we have a division outing for members and family / guests. This year's outing will be a trip to the Steam Institute in Owosso, Michigan, the home of Pierre Marquette 1225, which is under restoration. There will also be a stop of the Depot museum in Durand. Planning for the 2014 NCR regional convention is well underway. Various committees are hard at work with things that need to be done now. Minutes of February 2013 meeting of Division One were approved unanimously.

Next month we will be focusing on what you are working on now. Everyone is asked to bring something to talk about or show. Bring photos on a thumb drive. It will also include a big RIP track.

Dean Pyers has suggested a trip to Owosso and Durand, probably an 8-5 day. We have settled on June 8 as the best day.

There was no other business. The Business Meeting adjourned at 8:10pm.

After refreshments, Dex Decker gave a clinic on Tam Valley Depot products for powering turnouts and frogs.




